NOTES:

- 1. This form should be completed in every case and sent to **the Bishop** for his approval not less than **three (3) weeks before the proposed date for Baptism.**
- 2. If for any urgent reason the parish priest or deaconess has found it necessary to baptise without giving notice, he or she chould complete this form and send it to the Bishop with the reasons for his or her action.
- 3. If the Priest of Deaconess considers that a candidate requires more time and instruction, he or she may with-hold baptism even though the form has been completed.
- 4. If rightly used, the filling in of the form can be used both to impress the importance and dignity of the sacrament and to urge candidates to be extra careful in their preparation.
- 5. The original will be returned to the Priest by the Bishop and thus provides a written record of information which has to be entered in the Baptismal Register.
- 6. Please take care to provide the fullest possible information to enable the Bishop to carry out the duty laid upon him. No doubt it is difficult if the numbers are too many; it is better to aim at a smaller number of candidates at each baptism so that greater care may be taken. The more care taken over these preliminaries to baptism, the more likelihood there is of the candidates respecting the Sacrament.
- 7. When filling the particulars regarding religion/former religion, the person should say **Buddhism**, **Taoism**, **Hinduism**, **Animism**, **Ancestor-Worship**, etc, and not the indefinite term of "non-Christian".
- 8. Parental permission required for Applicants below 18 years of age (Section 2a):
 - a) For Child Applicants with **both parents still living**, BOTH the Father and Mother shall be required to sign giving permission for the Child to be baptized.
 - b) If one parent is deceased, ONLY the living parent shall be required to sign giving permission.
 - c) Should **both parents be deceased**, ONLY the Legal Guardian shall be required to sign giving permission.
- 9. During the absence of the Bishop from the Diocese, the form should be sent to his Commissary, duly appointed by him.
